BIODIVERSITY & APPEARANCE

- A wild flower meadow
- New plantings – by the Park Drive railings, the river bank etc.
- Trees pruned in front of the railway bridge for better views of the bridge and trains
- New paths – for instance, to the skatepark

COMFORT & CONVENIENCE

- Improved signage & improved lighting
- Cleaner, better toilets
- A drinking water fountain
- Upgrading the Tennis/Cricket Pavilion for use as a meeting place
- More tables and benches

PLAY & SMALL CHILDREN

- Mini-skatepark for smaller kids on trikes and scooters
- Water Play enhancing the paddling pool with small water jets and interactive play features
- Bigger Sandpit

PLAY & BIGGER CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE

- A "natural" play facility from climbing logs to climbing/balancing trail to multi-play "Jungle Jim"
- Bigger slide
- Zipwire

PLAY FOR ADULTS & ALL AGES

- Fitness Machines – either around the circuit or grouped in 1 or 2 places
- A multi-games facility - football goals, basketball hoops, table tennis
